2008 - 2010 JAMES R. MALLORY RESEARCH GRANT

The Canadian Study of Parliament Group (CSPG) is pleased to announce that the winner of the James R. Mallory Research Grant for the Study of Parliament for 2008-2010 is Dr. Kelly Blidook, Department of Political Science, Memorial University of Newfoundland. The research grant is worth \$8,000.

It is fitting that the CSPG established the Research Grant for the Study of Parliament in James R. Mallory's name. The late Professor Mallory was a member of the Department of Political Science at McGill University as well as a founder, former president and long-time member of the Canadian Study of Parliament Group. He was a leading scholar of parliamentary government, and wrote many sound and widely read analyses of the institution and issues related to it. His text, *The Structure of Canadian Government*, is still consulted by students of Canadian government.
